

# 2010-2011 DELIGEORGES FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP IN BIOMEDICAL ENGINEERING

The Deligeorges Family Scholarship is a gift of the Deligeorges family of Waterford, CT to undergraduate students with an interest in Biomedical Engineering. This year there will be 3 scholarships awarded at \$1000 each.

Students with an interest in biomedical engineering are encouraged to apply. Applicants may major in any discipline but they must be participating in, or be planning to participate in research involving biomedical engineering. Applications are due February 15, 2010. Financial need may be considered but this is not the primary factor in the selection. Research may begin as early as this coming summer and will continue through the following academic year. The applicant must be in-residence at the Storrs campus during the next academic year.

The application must include a one-page statement of the proposed biomedical engineering research project that describes your role in the project, along with a personal resume highlighting any previous laboratory or research experience. In addition, there should be a letter of support from a faculty mentor, and a current transcript.
