

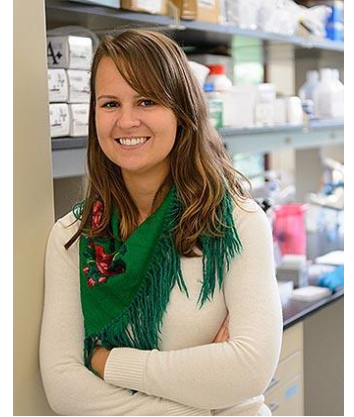
UConn-TIP Bioscience, Entrepreneurship & STEM

Summer Intern Program

Program Overview:

The UCONN-TIP Intern Program pairs UConn students with University start-up companies for on-campus, mentored research internships in STEM and Business.

- **Summer Intern Program:** mentored, paid, 10-week internships for current UConn undergraduates and Masters students (and UConn grads within 6 months). Any major is eligible.
- **Academic year program:** part-time research for earned academic credit during the school year. *Previous participation in the Summer Program is **required** for the Academic-year program.*



Company hosts: More than 30 start-up companies are in UConn's Technology Incubator Program (TIP) at Storrs, Farmington and Avery Point campuses. Companies are pursuing R&D in medical devices, software, infomatics, nanotechnology, pharmaceuticals, and more. Students participate in laboratory research in areas like engineering, molecular biology, stem cells, or computer sciences; or in business-related research such as marketing or accounting. Internship includes Entrepreneurship workshops.
